Tuition Assistance

Notre Dame Junior Academy families needing tuition assistance must apply each year. Preferred Deadline was March 1, 2010.

Ed Choice: Beginning this year all students with or applying to Ed Choice must also complete the tuition assistance application process.

Completing the tuition assistance application on-line:

- Go to www.nda.org
- Select the Admissions tab
- Select from the left menu: Facts Grant & Aid
- Select applicant sign-in
- Select from the right menu FGAA Checklist and print. This will guide you in supporting documentation to be submitted to complete the application.
- Log-in using your existing account or create a new account and follow the instructions for completing the on-line application.
- Mail to FACTS the supporting documentation required.

Completing the application by mail:

Hard copies of the Grant & Aid Assessment in English and Spanish are available in the kiosk in the main lobby and in the Business Office. Envelopes to mail the application and/or supporting documentation are also available.

Deadlines

March 1, 2010	Completed tuition assistance applications due to FACTS Tuition Management Company. To be complete all financial documentation must be submitted.
April 7	Tuition Assistance award letters will be mailed to families of returning students who completed their application by March 1, 2010.
April 14	PAYMENT DUE: \$200 registration fee To be paid during NDJA registration.

- June 18 **PAYMENT DUE: \$500** first payment.
- July 5 Payment plans with FACTS using the invoice option must be set up (see payment plans).
- August 2 **PAYMENT DUE: \$8,400** balance of tuition due or payment plan with ACH option must be set up with FACTS (see payment plans).
- If payment in full is not made – or the registration fee and first payment paid and an approved payment plan with FACTS in place – the student will not be permitted to attend school.*
