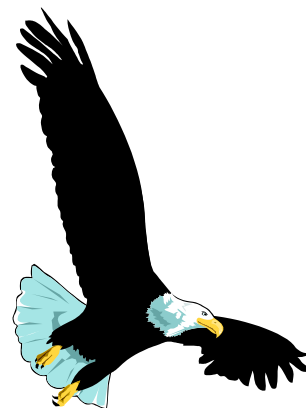

## *New Scholarship Opportunities*

### 1) The Ohio State University – Office of Minority Affairs

- **The Morrill Scholars Program** – Priority Deadline: December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010

Full-Tuition, Room and Board, Book Allowance, and Miscellaneous Expenses.

- **Freshman Foundation Program**

The Freshman Foundation Program offers need-based grants to Ohio students. Eligibility is determined on the basis of financial need as established by federal guidelines, and on academic and leadership credentials, race/ethnic/tribal background, county of residence, potential first-generation college graduate, and other factors.

Students must rank in the top 50% of their graduating class and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by the priority deadline of February 15th. Applicants to any Ohio State campus may be eligible for this program.

- 3) **Sylvania Area Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Program** - \$2,000 Scholarship available to City of Sylvania or Sylvania Township residents or residents who live within the school district attendance area. Must be graduating and planning to go to college. Pick up a copy of the application in the Guidance Galleria. Applications need to be postmarked no later than January 4<sup>th</sup>.

\*\*\* **ONU College of Business Administration: Leadership Scholarship:** \$17,000 per year scholarship for those who are accepted into ONU’s College of Business Administration, have a 3.30 GPA, a 23 ACT score, are in the top 20% of the senior class, and have demonstrated exemplary leadership. Students are selected by the Dean through the admission process.
- 6) **Baker College Culinary Institute (MI):** \$4,800 Baker College Career Scholarship. If interested, come to the Guidance Galleria and get the flyer with more information.
- 7) **Roanoke College (VA)** – Approximately \$175,000 over 4-years available if admitted into the Roanoke Scholars Program. Next deadline is January 10<sup>th</sup>, for the February competitions.

- 8) **Cazenovia College (NY)** – Multiple Merit-Based Scholarships, up to Full Tuition.

- 9) **Skidmore College (NY)** – Music, Math and Science Scholarships available.

- 10) **Davidson College (NC)** – The John Montgomery Belk Scholarship – Approximately \$47,179 renewable annually, plus a \$3,000 stipend for international study and other enrichment opportunities. Only 1 candidate can be nominated from NDA, so if you are interested, please see Mrs. Meier as soon as possible. The deadline for materials is November 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 11) **Eastern Michigan University** – Presidential Scholarship Competition: December 5<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup>, 8am-1pm. 16 students will receive a full-tuition four year full ride, 29 students will receive the Regents Gold Scholarship – worth approximately \$32,000 total. **All students who participate and meet minimum requirements are guaranteed a minimum \$12,000 four year Regents Scholarship.** Parents will have sessions while students take a test. - 12) **Ferris State University (MI) - Great Lakes Scholarship** – For Ohio residents to be able to pay in-state tuition for up to 15 credit hours. This estimated value is between \$4755-\$6420 per semester. You will be considered for this if you are accepted and enroll in an undergraduate degree-granting program at Ferris State University.
- 13) **Boston University- Trustee Scholarship Competition** – Four-year, Full-tuition scholarship to BU. Trustee Scholars are hand selected by a faculty committee, and are typically in the top ten percent of their class and are very active leaders in the school and community. Deadline: December 1<sup>st</sup>. Visit <http://bu.edu/admissions/scholarships> for more information. Multiple other scholarship opportunities available at this link.
- 14) **Bowling Green State University - Science and Math Education in Action Scholarship** - \$3,800 the first year, with increases each year up to at least \$5,200 the fourth year, for those considering teaching either high school science or math, or middle childhood science and math may also be eligible. Deadline is January 14<sup>th</sup>, and the application is available at [www.bgsu.edu/action](http://www.bgsu.edu/action).
- 15) **Fireside Catholic Publishing Essay Scholarship** – Five winners will receive a \$1,000 Cash Award for writing a 750-word essay on how your religious education is influencing your life. Only one applicant is allowed per school, so if you are interested, come down and pick up a copy of the official rules and application. The deadline is December 6<sup>th</sup>.
- 16) **Northwest Chapter of Credit Unions Scholarship** – Two \$2,000 scholarships and one \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded based on an application essay or video. Applications available in Guidance Galleria, and at [www.nwocu.org](http://www.nwocu.org).
- 17) **Promedica Fields of Green Scholarship Competition** – In teams of 2-4 students (from 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade), design a breakfast program for elementary school students. Each member of the winning team will receive a \$5,000 scholarship, and you would raise \$1,000 towards NDA's health and science programs. The winning program will be implemented in an elementary school within the 27 counties that Promedica Health System serves.
